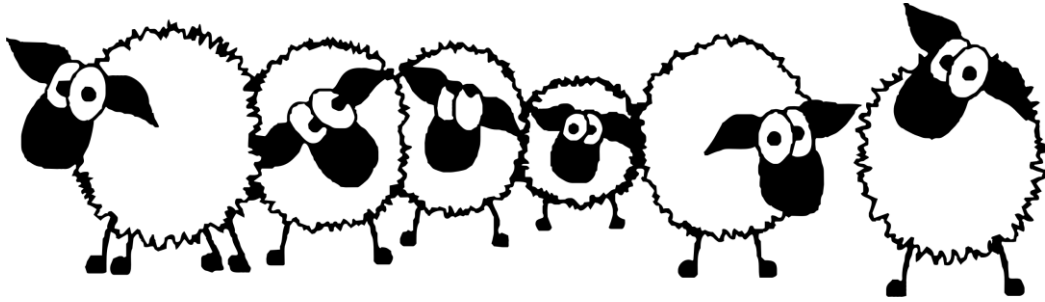


CHRISTMAS IN SHIRLEY
