Please collect from football through the main school gate and other clubs through the black gates. The gates will be locked to ensure the site is safe for clubs on the school field. **We would really appreciate your cooperation with the above. Thank you.**

LOCKDOWN

We wish to inform you that we are required to practise the procedure for locking down the school in the possible event of an intruder on our school site or within our school building with our children.

We will treat it just like a fire drill, which the children are very used to practising. The children will be asked to move and sit underneath their classroom tables, silently whilst the teachers assess the risks of windows and doors.

The children will be absolutely reassured that this is a practice lockdown to ensure the school was safe.
