Government funding cuts mean class sizes are increasing as teacher and TA numbers fall.

Subjects like music, art and IT are being cut from the curriculum.

You may not know that Education spending as part of our GDP is now at the same level as it was in the 1960s.

- There will be a real terms spending cut of 2.8% per pupil between 2017-18 and 2021-22
- £2.8 billion cuts in education since 2015
- Average cut to primary school is £45.4k
- This equates to a real term funding cut of 7% per pupil from 2015 – 2022

**Southampton schools face further cuts of £5 million!**

• Costs are rising all the time with increases in inflation, employment costs and pupil numbers are growing

• Class sizes in Primaries have increased since 2014
