- 3 maths tasks
- A project
- Spelling lists
- word of the day
- A maths challenge



We will keep in contact with you on the following days:

Monday mornings – your Year leader will 'marvellous me' to say your learning is on the website. Wednesday's – Your Class teacher will 'marvellous me' to say hello about your learning. Friday's – Mrs Gregory and Mrs Watts will 'marvellous me' to congratulate you on your learning. In addition to these tasks all children in all year groups have been given access to 'Education City'. This is an excellent online programme that helps you practice your learning for English and Maths. Your grownups have had a marvellous me with the log in details.



Please make sure you continue with your 'Love of Reading' books at home or listening to stories. You can do this online (which are free) or from CD's you may have at home. Free sites are detailed on the website grown-ups. There is a brilliant website called https://www.oxfordowl.co.uk/for-home/ for children to continue their colour sequence books.

As well as core learning we would like you to continue with your topic learning. A project with a range of learning tasks and resources will be uploaded to the main page for your year group. Your teacher will send you a 'Marvellous Me' message each week to encourage and remind you to complete your tasks.

At Shirley we value all of the curriculum so take time to; get some fresh air, take part in PE, play a board game with your family, listen to music, colour or paint. There are lots of other activities you can do along with the learning we set you each week.

Please remember that although you may be learning at home, you are still part of the Shirley Infant School family, and you continue to make us proud. We know that this is a very different time for everyone. We know that it is strange because you are not at school and you will miss being with your friends and the grown-ups.

All of the grown-ups miss you very much and seeing your smiley faces, which always cheers us up. We cannot wait to have our little stars back in school again, hopefully soon!
