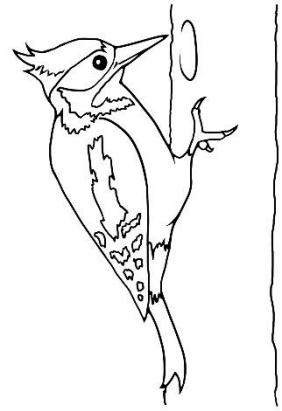


How exciting! You are moving from Year 1 to Year 2.
