We have had a wonderful start to our summer term. The children have been working so hard and we are very proud of their perseverance skills. We know this can be a worrying time but we have lots of curriculum support in place. Our PSHE topic focuses on change and the children participate in various activities including circle times, stories and group discussions. The children across all year groups will participate in many outdoor transition activities such as DPA, stories with class teachers who will be in their year group, interviewing children from the year group above and many, many more. Obviously we want to make this change a positive experience for the children so teachers plan carefully who will be placed together in each class to ensure a balance of gender, ability and obviously taking into account friendships which encourage positive learning.

TRANSITION

The children will be visiting their new class and meeting their new teacher next week on **Friday 2nd July**.

We have written a very tight risk assessment around this day and due to the new government regulations we are moving the day from a Wednesday to a Friday. This means we will not be crossing children back into classes the next day and we can allow a full deeper clean on the Friday night and then a 48 hour window before the children re-enter their normal classes. A lot of work has gone into the planning and preparation for 'Shuffle up day'. We have sat on many local authority and Hamwic meetings to come up with a plan. Mrs Hixon and myself have meticulously planned the day to minimise the risk as much as we can. However, as always, we can only say we have minimised the risk. We will have full ventilation as always and the children will be taking their resources up with them and not using the previous classes. On the Friday morning to ensure there are no asymptomatic carriers, we will ask our staff to take an additional lateral flow test. We also ask that all the adults in your household do a lateral flow test on the morning of 2nd July too please. We would be very grateful for this extra precaution. Please **do not** send your children if they are at all poorly. This is so important! If your child can not attend we will support them with an alternative 'shuffle up' please do not worry.

We hope this day gives some more reassurance for the children and yourselves. We look forward to a fabulous last four weeks of this term.

Reports and assessment information

Please note that the reports this year will tell you where you child was on track to achieve as we are not allowed this year to say they have achieved as some areas of the curriculum have not been taught due to COVID. Year 1 will take the Phonics check in Year 2 in

the Autumn term.



SPORTS DAY

Sports day will be on Friday 9th July. The children will stay in Year group bubbles and with their key staff. Please ensure you apply sun cream to your children in the morning and they bring their water bottle and hat. Children can wear their PE kits into school on this day. For a PE kit we ask they wear a comfortable t-shirt with no hanging accessories and shorts or jogging bottoms. They can wear their school jumper or a sport hoody/jumper. Children should be in plimsolls or trainers

too. We will be taking photos of the day to share with you and these will be loaded to google classroom by the following week.
