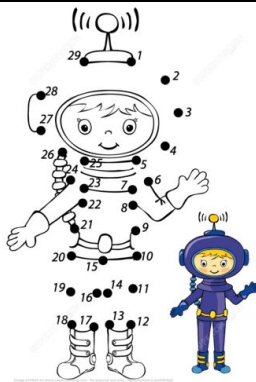


Here are some activities you might like to try now you've heard the story

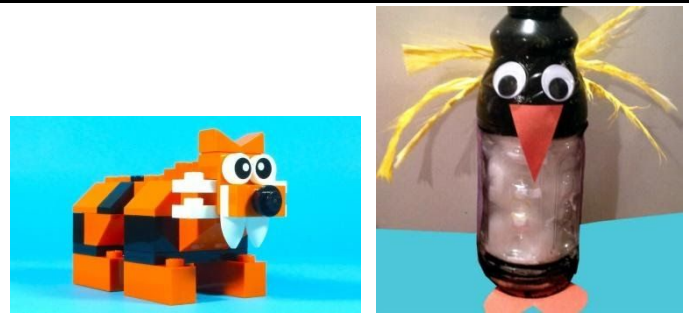


Milo thinks the stars look like a giant dot to dot. Can you do one of these space dot to dots?
