Family Hub parenting and community programmes for 2024 Providing support and advice to parents and carers is at the centre of the work at Family Hubs.

We understand that sometimes parenting can be challenging. So we would like to give parents and carers the skills they need to support the child/ren they care for.

<u>Family Hubs</u> offer a range of parenting and community programmes to assist families as they grow.

There are a various courses available, such as Infant Massage for Babies from Birth to Pre-crawling which will teach parents and carers how simple strokes may help babies with wind or constipation. Also Understanding Behaviour which aims to empower parents/carers to understand behaviours and feel motivated to respond in a more positive way.
