REMINDER

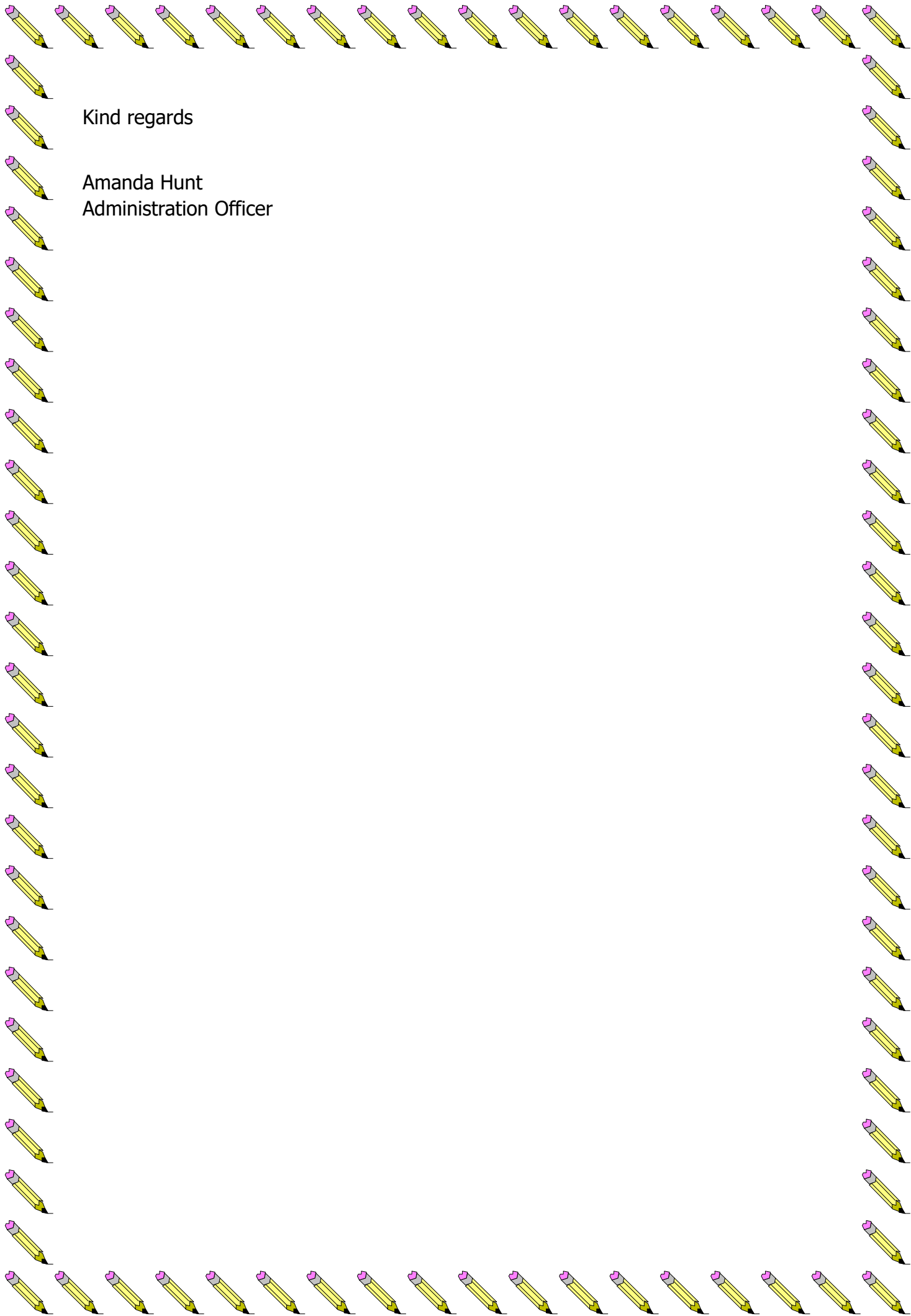
