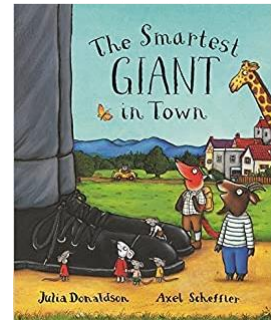




The Smartest Giant in Town

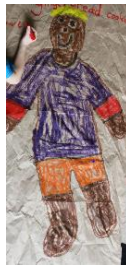
Here are some activities you might want to try at home now you have listened to the story 😊
