
As part of our space topic please can all the children bring in a **small** cereal box e.g a breakfast bar box over the next few weeks. Thank you - we will be making moon buggies.

Celebration event - Thursday 6th February: 2.45pm – The children will be sharing their Peter Pan stories with you.


