Head Teacher Message

Dear families.

This week held World Mental Health Day (10 October) which was an opportunity to raise awareness of mental health, how to look after it and where to go for help if you are struggling. We support children with thinking about having a healthy mind and sharing worries. We teach them to use their zones of regulation and 'Bubbletime' to regulate themselves or ask for help. You could encourage your little ones to use these strategies at home with you too.

There are small actions you can take also to look after your mental wellbeing to help you feel better and more in control, such as taking time to do mindful breathing exercises, going for a walk, catching up for a chat with a friend or loved one, or even planning an hour of screen-free time in your day.

The NHS Every Mind Matters website has lots of free NHS-approved tips and advice to help you be kind to your mind. You can also search 'mental health' on the Southampton City Council website for links to local mental health support services.
