
# INFANTS & JUNIORS COVID UPDATE

## Parent COVID Guidance – March 2022

**We recognise the Government guidance has change but we would like to ask our parents and staff to continue to follow the recommended guidance in order to protect our community.**

Anyone who develops 1 of the 3 main COVID-19 symptoms it is recommended that they stay at home and self-isolate and take a PCR test. They self-isolate if they get a positive test result for a minimum of 6 days, even if they have had a recent negative lateral flow test

Examples of when to end self-isolation if you have had COVID-19 symptoms or have received a positive COVID-19 test result



### Lateral flow tests are taken by people who do not have COVID-19 symptoms.

If you choose to continue to use LF tests and your child tests positive, we recommend they isolate for at least 6 days

Other measures: The schools will continue to have a focus on hygiene and cleaning. It is no longer required that staff wear masks but they may do if they wish.

## Sending emails

When sending in an email to the school office, can you please make sure you always put your child's name and class in the subject area. This makes it a lot quicker for the office staff to make sure the correct person gets the details of the email.
