Dear families,

We have had a wonderful first week back with your little ones.

#### Warmer Weather

With the warmer weather approaching, it is important that your child brings in their water bottle each day. We would advise that you provide your child with a sun hat too - clearly named. The children are often outside for many parts of our curriculum and we would advise that they start having sun cream on during the day. It is best applied in the morning before they come to school and there are many long lasting creams available. The children are allowed to bring sun creams into school, however they will have to apply it themselves as staff are not permitted to do this. Please label bottles clearly with your child's name and class.
