My Child at School App — MCAS


As we have previously communicated we are now using a new online app for payments, weekly communication and emails

Community Information

Over 40s can now book a vaccination

Are you aged 40 or over? Say YES to the COVID-19 vaccine.

You can get the COVID-19 vaccine if:

- you're aged 40 or over
- You'll turn 40 before 1 July 2021

You are at high risk from coronavirus (clinically extremely vulnerable)

- You are an eligible frontline health or social care worker
- You have a condition that puts you at higher risk (clinically vulnerable)
- You are a main carer for someone at high risk from coronavirus

You must book your appointment before you go to a vaccination centre. You can book appointments at a larger vaccination centre or a pharmacy that provides COVID-19 vaccinations.

If you have received an invitation, book your appointment call 119, or contact your GP surgery to book

Please make sure you plan your journey responsibly to allow for as much social distancing as possible.

<u>A new study by Public Health England</u> (PHE) has shown that one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine reduces household transmission by up to half, but be sure to schedule and attend vaccinations for **both** doses when you book.

Due for your second dose of the vaccine soon?

You will be eligible for your second dose of the COVID-19 vaccination from 10-12 weeks after your first dose. Please review <u>NHS programme guidance on vaccinations</u> for more details about where you receive your second dose.

Depending on where you were first vaccinated, the ways of confirming second dose appointments differ; this is due to the logistics of operating different sites and different vaccines, compounded by vaccine delivery schedules.

- If you were invited by your **GP practice** (e.g. Adelaide Health Centre, Ladies Walk Surgery, Chessel Avenue Surgery, St Peters Surgery, University Health Centre), wait to be contacted by your GP.
- If you were invited for vaccination at a **hospital site**, (e.g. Solent NHS Trust Hospital), then you will be contacted by the hospital site to book your second dose appointments.
- If you went to a mass vaccination site or pharmacy site (e.g. Applemore Leisure Centre, Boots Pharmacy, West Quay Retail Park), you can book your second appointment online via the National Booking Service www.nhs.uk or by calling 119 if you do not already have one.

Book your second dose

Excellent progress continues to be made with the delivery of the COVID-19 vaccination programme across Hampshire and the Isle of Wight.

More than 1.36m vaccines have now been delivered to those in our communities who are most at risk.
