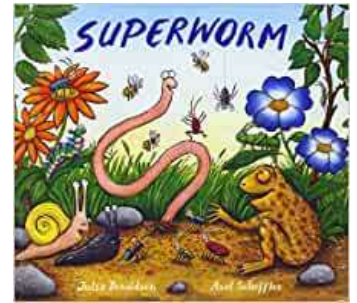


Superworm activities

<p>Lizards are a group of 3,800 cold-blooded reptiles, varying from a few centimetres long to the 3 m long Komodo dragon.</p> 	<p>Lizards move in really weird - meeping, scurrying and slithering. Some can glide. Unlike mammals, their limbs stick out sideways rather than downwards.</p>
