

Year 2 Parents

We are really excited to be welcoming you and your children to Shirley Junior School in September. As part of our transition we will be asking parents to complete an information form to help us plan for a smooth transition and meet the needs of the individual children.

We have no plans to make any changes to the current class groups as we feel the children will benefit from moving up together as an established class group. If you have any concerns about your own child, you may wish to add this information to the form. We really look forward to getting to know you all in the coming months. We will send out a letter with more information about the transition activities at the end of this half term.

School Streets: timed road closure

Please be aware that there is now a timed road closure around the perimeter of the school.

The roads directly outside of school temporarily close to motor vehicles to become a pedestrian and cycle zone for a short period of time at the beginning and end of the school day. Closing the road space outside schools at drop off and pick up times provides a much safer environment for everyone at peak times and helps those who are able to walk, cycle or scoot to school.

School Street schemes are in place from Monday to Friday, 8:00am – 9:30am & 2:15pm – 3:45pm (except where noted otherwise) during the school term.

Access is maintained for residents who live within the closed area, emergency vehicles, blue badge holders and school escort vehicles.



As the weather is now beginning to warm up, please can we remind you to ensure children are dressed appropriately;



- Please provide your child with a named sun hat
- Please apply sun cream before children come to school
- Sun cream can be brought into school, **but children must be able to apply it themselves**
- Please ensure jumpers are **named**, as children do like to take them off when it's hot
- Children should continue to wear sensible school shoes
- Please make sure children have a full water bottle for the day
- Please provide a light weight coat for Year R's particularly as the weather can change and we are still outside a lot!

Attendance

As COVID restrictions have eased and it has become possible to travel again, we have received an increase in applications for leave of absence (holiday forms). This has meant that it is taking longer to process the forms, please bear with us. We would also like to take this opportunity to remind you that it is important that your child/ren attend school regularly and that they are only absent when they are ill or when personal circumstances mean it is unavoidable. All requests for holidays will be declined and parents may be liable to a fine of £60 per parent per child. Please can you ensure that all requestes for leave are submitted at least 3 weeks before the date of the leave unless there are exceptional circumstances.

Full-fibre broadband available for tenants

In today's digital world, fast and reliable broadband is essential, but in a recent survey of Southampton council tenants, 25% of respondents reported that they never access the internet, with 62% of this group either not having access, or not knowing how to access the internet. So, we're working to improve digital inclusion and have recently signed an agreement with full-fibre internet provider Toob to enable all 18,000 council homes across the city to access the latest broadband technology.

The network is being rolled out to council homes over the next 18 months. Multi modal travel app insight project

The Solent Future Transport Zone (FTZ) is a trial programme funded by the Department for Transport to help make journeys easier, smarter and greener in the Solent region. The programme is supported by the local authorities of Hampshire, Portsmouth, Southampton and Isle of Wight.

The research team at the University of Portsmouth would like to conduct a series of four surveys (initial and follow up) to understand individuals' travel behaviour as part of the FTZ Programme.
