

What I already know...

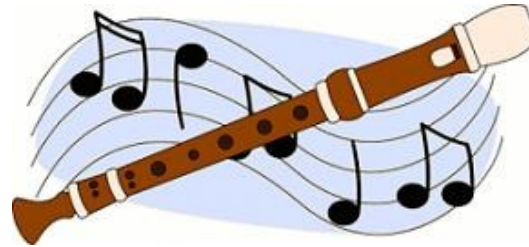
- Hold a recorder correctly and to make a soft gentle sound.
