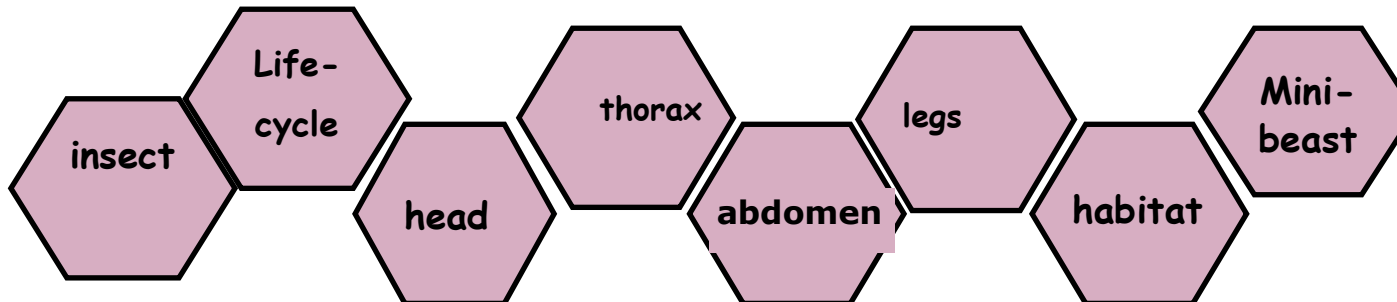
I know that things grow and change. I can make observations and talk about why things occur (TW ELG)
