
<u> Plurals</u>

Rules:

If a word ends in a ch, x, s, ss, z you add -es (box - boxes) If a word ends in f or fe you drop the f/fe and add -ves (knife - knives)

If a word ends in y - you either drop the y and add ies (city - cities) OR if there is a short vowel in front of it, you just add s (boy - boys)
