
# Year 1 Reading Activities

When we look at a book as a whole class we read the story and each day complete activities to support our reading knowledge (these will be based upon the reading dogs you have seen in our other reading activities).



Please choose which activities you think would be suitable for your child (as we know that all children are learning at different levels) and have lots of fun! Please take photographs or record any amazing work in the Home Learning books for us to see when we can all be together again.

#### Activity 1 - Read the story and learn how to retell it
