<u>Year 2</u> Suffixes - ly

Suffixes are letters that you add on to the end of words to change their meanings. Most words you can just add **ly** to. If you add **ly** to the end of a verb (*doing word*), it changes it to an **adverb** (*describing how you do something*). The rules below will show you some exceptions.

Rules:

If a word ends consonant y - you drop the y and add ily (happy - happily) If a word ends in le - replace it with ly (terrible - terribly)
