Inference Questions with Inference Iggy

Inference Iggy will help you hunt for clues in a text about how someone might be feeling or why something is happening.

Vocabulary to discuss- 'ght' words to look out for

Bought, naughty, laughed, thought

Questions:

- *Before reading the book*

Remind your child about alternate pronunciations for sounds. Sound out and blend a difficult word and if it doesn't make sense then try using a different sound.

- *Pause at Page 3*

How does Dad describe Gran? Why do you think she's like a 'naughty girl'? Do you agree with Dad?

- *Pause at Page 6*

Why is Kipper laughing at the men and the piano? Do you think they're funny?

- *Pause at Page 9*

Why was Kipper angry? How would you feel in a magical world with no colour?

- *Pause at Page 12*

Why didn't Kipper want to help the men?

- *Page 14*

How are the two men feeling when Kipper crashed the piano? How would you feel if something special to you had broken?

- *Pause at Page 19*

Why do you think Gran is squirting Mum with the super soaker?

- *Pause at Page 23*

How is Kipper feeling now? Is he still angry? What can you see that tells you how he is feeling? Is it the words or pictures or both?

- *Read to the end.*

Why do you think Gran is allowed to know about the key but Mum and Dad are not? What would happen if Mum and Dad knew? Would it still work?
