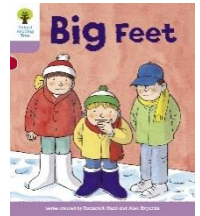


## 'Big Feet' by Roderick Hunt



### Inference Questions with Inference Iggy

Inference Iggy will help you hunt for clues in a text about how someone might be feeling or why something is happening.

### Prediction Questions with Predicting Pip

Predicting Pip tries to see the future and she will help you work out what might happen next.



### Tricky words- repetitive phrase

Come and look at this.

#### Questions:

- *Look at the front cover.*  
What can you think of that has big feet? Can you think of 5 different things?
- *Look at the front cover.*  
Remind the children that we have to remember what some words look like as we can't sound them out (blend them). Then there are words that we can try and blend, ask your child to read the title. Remind them that 'ee' is a digraph (2 letters together to make 1 sound).
- *Page 1*  
Point to each word and read it with your child. Do they recognise any of the tricky words?
- *Page 1*  
What do they predict is making the footprints? Can they guess?
- *Pause at Page 3*  
How are the characters feeling? Do you think it is a big monster?
- *Pause at Page 5*  
How do you know the word says 'dinosaur'? Can you sound it out? Is it a tricky word? What can you use to help you work out the word? (Eg, prominent sounds, picture clues)
- *Pause at Page 7*  
What do you think Chip is looking at around the corner? Can you make a prediction?
- *Page 8*  
Why is Dad wearing shoes like that? What do they do?
