
Oxford Owl - Red

Difficult words to talk about

Questions:

- Look at the front cover.
 Can you think of any games that you might play where you might say 'Can you see me?'
- Look at the front cover.
 Practise reading the title in different voices (whisper it/shout/squeaky mouse voice etc...). Now can you point to the word that says 'me'?
- Page 1
 Point to each word and read it with your child. Do they recognise any of the tricky words? Does the word say 'me' or 'my'? What is different?
- Page 2
 Read the sentence and find the dog. Can you play the I spy game with other things in the picture? (Take it in turns).
- Page 4 and 5
 Look at all of the pictures on the wall. Which picture is your favourite? Why?
 Discuss some of the pictures and talk about them using adjectives (describing words)
 to describe them.
- Page 6 and 7
 Who is Kipper talking to? How do you know?
- Page 8
 Which toy do you think is Kipper's favourite? Why do you think that?

Challenge - Can you write a label for the toys in the book? Can you write a label for the toys in your bedroom? Remember to use all of your sounds to help you.
