Suffixes - er -est

Suffixes are letters that you add on to the end of words to change their meanings. Most words you can just add **er** and **est** to. The rules below will show you some exceptions.

Rules:

If a word ends in a y, you drop the y and add i (happy - happier happiest)

If a word ends in an e, replace it with er/est (late - later latest)

If a word ends in a short vowel and consonant, double the consonant (big - bigger biggest)
