

English, Activity 1 - Week 7



Tricky word SPLAT!

For this activity your child might want to make their own splatter to 'splat' the tricky word or they can use their hand if they wish to.

Collect the tricky word flashcards you made from previous home learning from the list below. Choose 10 tricky words from the pile and flash them to your child. Then find a large space and lay the cards facing upwards on the floor/carpet with space between each word. Tell your child that you will say a tricky word and they need to find it and tap it saying 'SPLAT' at the same time. To make this game a little harder you could add a timer or put the tricky word into a sentence for your child to listen to e.g 'You will need a coat' your child will SPLAT tricky word 'you'.

Ask your child to look at the tricky word for three seconds, turn it over and then write it down! Remember to check your spelling afterwards ©
