# trail

1. To drag along behind on the ground.
2. To follow the scent or trace.
3. A path.

## Examples

1. The boy trailed his coat behind him.
2. The dog trailed the cat.
3. He followed the trail to the cabin through the forest.

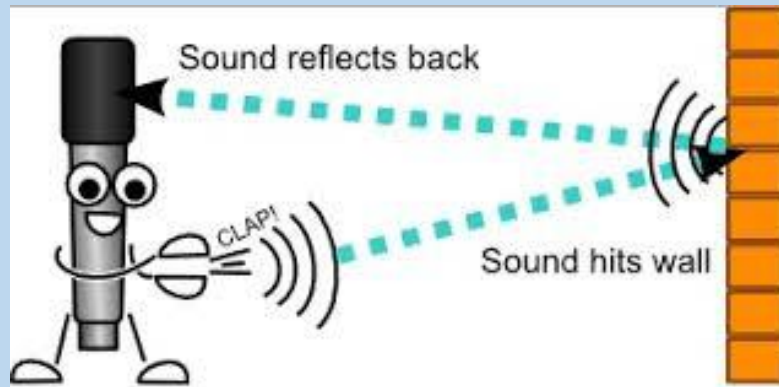


# echo

The repeating of a sound caused by the bouncing of sound waves.

## Examples

- I heard the echo of my footsteps in the empty hallway.



# combine

To bring or join together into a whole.

## Examples

- He combined together water and soil to make mud.



# period

1. A section of time with a set beginning and end.
2. A section of time in history.

## Example

- 1. We will go on holiday for a period of 3 weeks.
- 2. We are learning about the Victorian period in England.



# vault

1. An arch made of stone or brick.
2. To jump over something.

## Examples

- 1. The Romans were the first to use vaults in buildings.
- 2. Tom vaulted over the fence.
