Sharks and Islands

Collect the tricky word flashcards you made from previous home learning from the list below. Choose 8 tricky words from the pile and flash them to your child. Then find a large space and lay the cards face down on the floor/carpet with space between each word. Tell your child they will be playing a game called 'Sharks and Islands'. Your child needs to start by moving around the open space, pretending to swim, taking care to not touch the words. This open space becomes the sea and the words become islands. When you say "Quick the sharks are coming" your child needs to jump onto a tricky word, pick it up and read it to you so they are safe from the shark. If they can read it to you they get a point, if they cannot read it to you the shark gets a point. Repeat this, replacing the tricky words when they have all been read. Have fun!

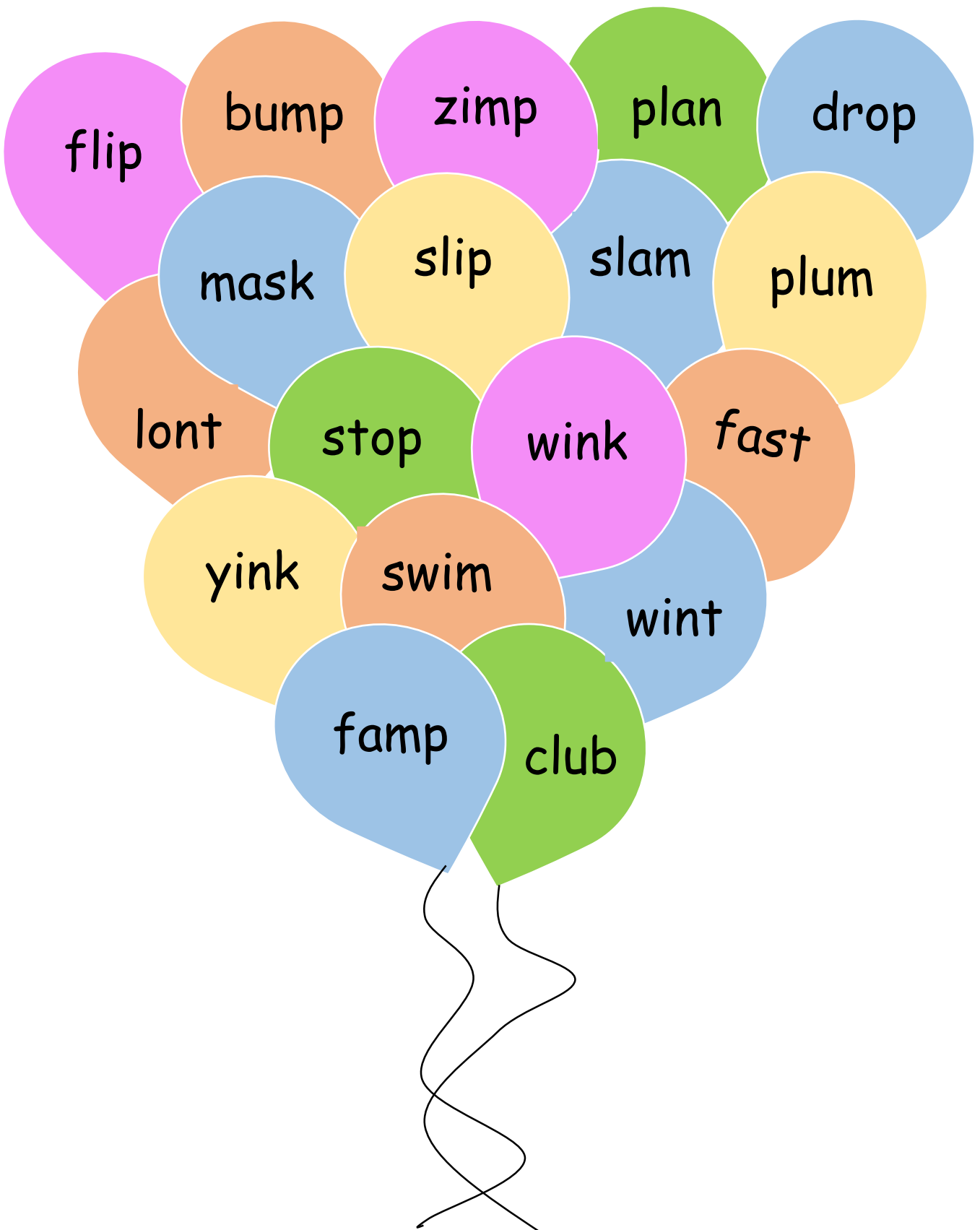


Ask your child to read the words on the balloons below. Can they tick or cross the real and fake words?
