Suffixes - ness -ment

Suffixes are letters that you add on to the end of words to change their meanings. Most words you can just add -ness and -ment to.

If a root word ends in a -y, drop the y and add an i (e.g. happy - happiness) If a root word ends in a -vowel e, drop the e (argue - argument)
