Sequence Questions with Sequencing Suki

Sequencing Suzi likes everything in order! She will help you sequence the events in a text.



Inference Questions with Inference Iggy

Inference Iggy will help you hunt for clues in a text about how someone might be feeling or why something is happening.



Longer words with ore than one syllable

Happy, stinky, garden, flower, insect, rainforest, important, fantastic

Questions:

- *Look at the longer words in the box above.*
Discuss how to read a word with more than 1 syllable. Explain what a syllable is (a word that has more than 1 'beat'. It's the vowels in the word that gives the beat). Try saying some common names/ words and clap each beat. For example;
 - Dog, cat, horse - 1 clap
 - Rabb-it, donk-ey, monk-ey - 2 claps
 - Butt-er-fly, drag-on-fly - 3 claps
 - Cat-er-pill-er, pray-ing mant-is - 4 claps
- *Read through the book together*
Talk about any new words (botanist) and read the more difficult words together. Discuss what will happen next. Make some predictions and have a good guess.
- *Page 22*
Using the pictures, retell the story again in your own words. Remember to talk about the time words (first, then, next, after that, in the end, finally) to help you retell the story.
- Using the pictures below, can you cut them out and put them into the correct sequence?
- Can you mix up the pictures, remove one of them and spot which part of the story is missing? How do you know?
- Can you choose one of the pictures and add some speech bubbles or labels?



- Can you use the pictures and make your own story book? Make sure you write your own sentence to go with each picture.
