Retrieval Questions with Rex Retriever

Rex Retriever will help you to go into a text and retrieve the facts.

<u>CVC words (Consonant vowel consonant)</u> Remember to point to each letter and blend them together to make the whole word.

Questions:

- Look at the front cover.
 Sound out each word and read it by blending the sounds together. M-i-x. Don't forget to point to each letter as you read it so you don't miss any of it out.
- Look at the front cover.

Read the title. What do you think the bug is mixing? Have you ever mixed something before?

• Page 1

Point to each word and read it with your child. What does Bob Bug have? Can you point to the words which tell you the answer?

- Page 2 and 3
 What does Bob cut up first? What does he do next?
- Page 4 and 5

Look at the pictures of fruit on the page. What can you see? Read the words and see if you were right.

- Page 6 and 7
 How many nuts does Bob tip into the mix? What does his Mum and Dad say?
- Page 8
 What does Bob Bug say when he tastes the mix?

Challenge - Can you make a mixture all of your own? You could write down the ingredients too.
