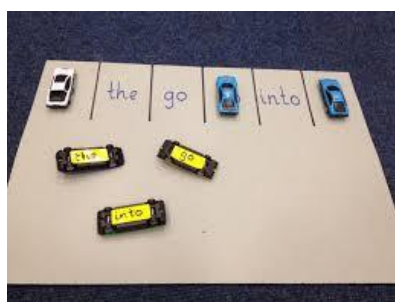


English, Activity 1 - Summer 2 - Week 1

Ask your child to look at the *CVCC/CCVC* words below (these can be copied out onto paper) and ask them to work out the missing letters.



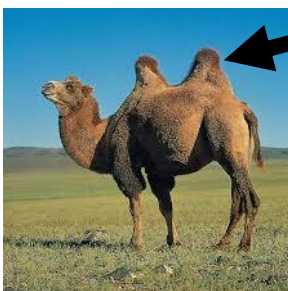
Can they write a story about one of the animals in the pictures?
