### Prediction Questions with Predicting Pip

Predicting Pip tries to see the future and she will help you work out what might happen next.



### Inference Questions with Inference Iggy

Inference Iggy will help you hunt for clues in a text about how someone might be feeling or why something is happening.



As you read through the book, please make sure you read the introduction to each new chapter with your child to ensure they understand the next part of the book.

### Questions: Introduction

- What do you think Team X will find inside the pyramid?
- Do you think real pyramids have tracks inside them to ride on?
- How do the MITE's feel when they are building the pyramid?
- Why do you think Ant is eager?
- Talk through the Adults page together before moving to Chapter 2.

### Questions: Chapter 1 - A Thrilling Ride

- How is Cat feeling as they raced into the pyramid?
- What do you think is in the dark passage?
- How did they feel when Cat made them jump? How do you feel when someone makes you jump?
- What is an echo? Have you ever been in a place where you can make an echo sound?
- How would you feel if you saw lots of beetles 'scuttling out of the wall'?

### Questions: Chapter 2 - Traps!

- Why do you think the beetles are chasing Team X?
- What could the 'loud grinding noise' be?
- How were the team feeling as the sand flowed 'almost filling the chamber'?

### Questions: Chapter 3 - Race Against Time

- How would you feel if you were trapped inside the pyramid?
- What do you think the Team will do next? How will they escape?

- Can you find out some more information about the Pyramids?
- Make a poster or a fact book about your findings.
