Retrieval Questions with Rex Retriever

- Page 4 and 5

Look at the picture and see if you can find all the bugs. Now read the two pages and see if you were right.

- Page 6 and 7
 How big is the bug dad has found? Point to the words that tell you the answer.
- Page 8
 What bug had dad found?
