

• How do you think the people felt when they had to go down to the shelters? Can you think of lots of different adjectives to describe their emotions.

Questions: Read up to page 27 and pause.

- How do you feel reading this book? Does it make you feel happy, sad, excited? Why
 does it make you feel this way?
- Can you predict what might happen next? Will the children get split up?
