Verbs	Nouns	Adjectives	Adverbs
A word that describes what a person or thing does, such as: run, hit, rain, be, seem, become, grow	A word that identifies a person, place thing idea or quality, such as: woman, dog, building, London, truth, birth	A word that describes a noun, such as: red, bad, giant, hairy, shy	A word that gives more information about a verb adjective or another adverb, such as: lazily, easily, abroad, very
