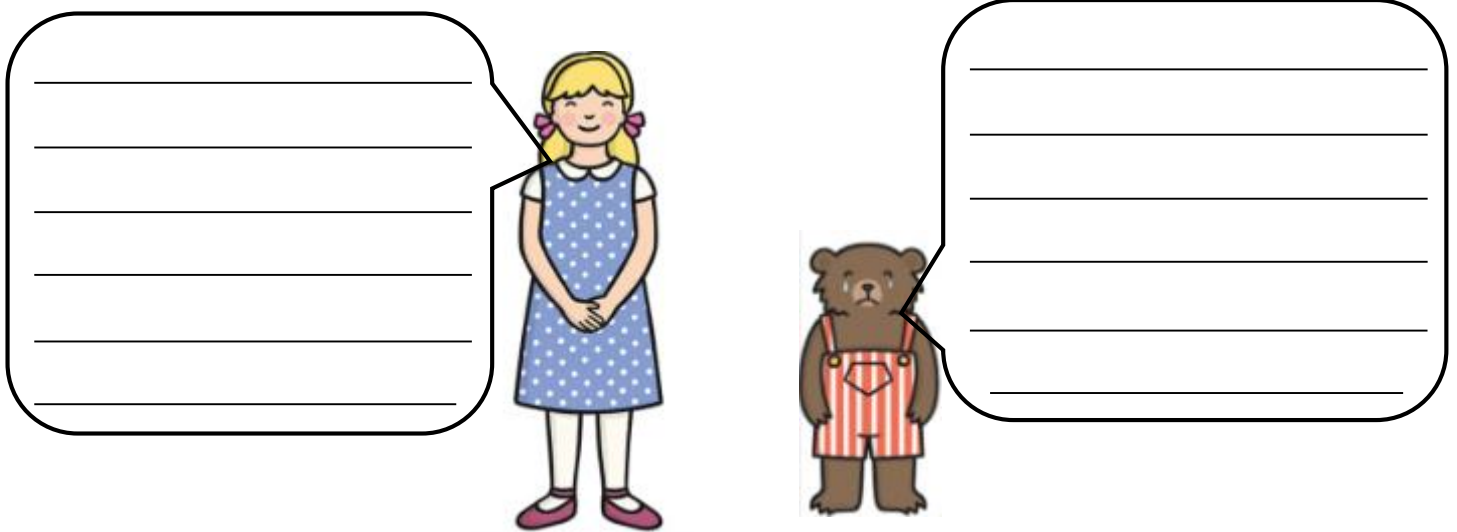
Writing - Exclamation in sentences
