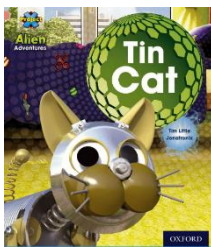


'Tin Cat'



Vocabulary Questions with Vocabulary Victor

Vocabulary Victor will help you to look at how authors and poets have chosen to use certain words and phrases.



CVC words (Consonant vowel consonant)

Remember to point to each letter and blend them together to make the whole word.

Questions:

Look at the front cover.

- Read the title together. 'T-i-n / c-a-t'
- What does tin mean?
- Can they use the picture to help them guess if they are unsure?

Read page 2 -3.

- Once your child has read the labels ask them to point to ant, the kit and the mat.
- What is a kit?
- Have you ever used a kit before?

Read page 4-5.

- What does the word 'tap' mean?
- Can you show an action for 'tap'?

Read page 8-11. (Ask your child to physically show the actions for these words.)

- Show me what 'sit' means.
- Show me what 'nod' means.
- Show me what 'sags' means.
- Show me what 'naps' means.

Extra ideas

- Using the story map on page 12, ask your child to retell the story in their own words. What happened at the beginning? What happened next? etc.
- Which part of the story did they like the most?
- Can they make a model of a cat or another animal with some recycling materials?
