- 4. Why was Jack's mum angry? What did she do?
- 5. What did Jack notice the next day?
- 6. What did he decide to do? How was he feeling about it?
- 7. Can you list some of the things Jack found at of the top of the beanstalk?
- 8. What was the giant saying?
- 9. What did Jack decide to do?
- 10. How did Jack defeat the giant?

Can you use the picture cards below to sequence the story of Jack and the Beanstalk? You will need to cut them out and jumble them up for your child to re-order. Alternatively, you can use them as prompts for your child to retell the story in their own words.

















### Task 3
