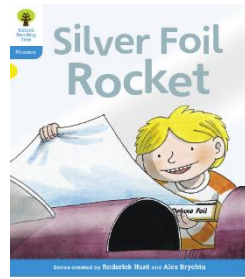


Oxford Owl - **Yellow**

Vocabulary Questions with Vocabulary Victor

Vocabulary Victor will help you to look at how authors and poets have chosen to use certain words and phrases.



Focus phonics for this book:

Oi, er, or, ure.

Can your child think of any words with these sounds in?

Questions:

- *Look at the front cover.*
Can you think of anything that is the colour silver?
Why does Kipper need foil?
- *Read page 1*
What is a carnival?
Can you think of different reasons to have carnivals?
- *Pause at page 8.*
What are 'barrels'?
What shape is a barrel?
Can your child point to the 'fins' they are putting on the rocket? Have you ever heard the word 'fins' describing something different?
- *Pause at page 13.*
What is a banner?
Have you ever seen one before?
What does 'Kids in orbit' mean?

Extra ideas:

- If you were at the summer carnival what would you have done to win the cup? You could design an idea - draw the picture and label it.
- Can you research more about space and design a rocket? Make sure to add labels for the different parts of the rocket.
- Can you write the story but change what the children choose to do for the festival? Maybe they choose the rock band and become famous!
