1. Make bread

- 2 cups white flour
- 1/4 cup cream of tartar
- 1/2 cup salt
- 2 Tablespoons vegetable oil
- 2 cups water
- Porridge Oats



3. Small world play

Have fun with any small world animals you may have and act out the story using the story language you have learnt. You can also use your playdoh as extra sensory play for your animals to play in!



4. Puppets

Make your own puppets to role play the story. There are many ways to do this... stick puppets...paper plates...finger puppets...have a look at some ideas below.
