### Inference Questions with Inference Iggy

Inference Iggy will help you hunt for clues in a text about how someone might be feeling or why something is happening.

### Prediction Questions with Predicting Pip

Predicting Pip tries to see the future and she will help you work out what might happen next.



### Tricky words:

He, me, you, all

### Questions:

- *Look at the front cover.*  
What do you think the King is going to wish for? What would you like to wish for?
- *Page 2*  
What word tells you where he wants to go? Why do you think he wants to go up?
- *Page 4*  
Which words describe what the box looks like?
- *Pause at Page 5*  
How do you think the people feel when the King says 'get me a box!'
- *Page 6 - 7*  
Why do you think the King wants lots of boxes? What do you think he is going to do with them?
- *Page 8 - 9*  
Was your guess right? How do you think all of the people are feeling? What could they be thinking?
- *Pause at page 12 - 13*  
What do the people say to the King? Do you think they are going to be right? Why are the King's words in bold (darker writing)?
- *Page 14 - 15*  
Did you make the right prediction?

**Challenge:** Play fastest finger first. Choose a page and ask your child to find the tricky words as quickly as possible. For example; point to 'you etc...
